### Welcome Back

### School Library

Now that the school building works are complete, our library is no longer needed as a classroom and we are happy to say that next week it will be up and running for children to borrow books again. Each child is allowed to borrow three books at any one time and will generally have the opportunity to visit the library with their class every week to select, renew or return books.

The library has a wonderful assortment of both fiction and non-fiction books for the children to explore and enjoy. We would like to keep it exciting for the children, by making sure we always have a full and varied selection. We ask for your support by ensuring that your child looks after any library books taken home and that all books are returned to school by the end of each term.

**At the end of each term, a fixed amount of £5.00 will be charged for any books that are lost, damaged or not returned to the school library. This fixed replacement charge will be added to the child's SchoolMoney account to be paid online.**

While we always encourage good attendance, it is important that children do not come to school if they are not well enough. When a child has been sick or has had diarrhoea, they should not attend school for 48 hours after the last incidence of illness to ensure they are not infectious when they return to school.
