The challenge for children will be to design and create an exciting science experiment for their peers to see. The experiment can showcase any science-related topic they wish, however some examples from previous years have included rubber boiled eggs, home-made compasses and lava lamps. If you are unsure if your experiment would be allowed, please check with Mr Newnes or Mr Hodgson.

Those wishing to participate in the science Fair will need to complete the attached slip with your child's name and a brief summary of their experiment and return it to the school office by Friday 8th June.

Anyone wishing to participate in the Fair will have time over the holidays to have a practice run at demonstrating their experiment, before showing the real thing at the Fair.

Children not wishing to demonstrate an experiment at the Science Fair will have the opportunity to see all of the experiments during their afternoon session on Tuesday 12th June. Whilst doing this they can vote for their favourite experiments by giving a 1p, 2p or 5p coin to those that they like. The winning house will be the house which raises the most money, with all the proceeds going to a charity of the winning house's choice.

Parents and carers that would like to see all the experiments may also come and see them in action from 2:45 until 3:00 in the main school hall.
