End of Year Test Results

Congratulations to all the children involved in statutory testing in Year 1, Year 2 and Year 6.

We are pleased that we have increased the numbers reaching the expected levels in the Year 1 phonics check and the assessments at the end of Year 2. Our published results in Year 6 were also very strong, as shown below:
