





Where to drop off and pick up.

First thing in the morning, all children should line up in their classes at the Year 4 cloakroom entrance. This entrance is also where they can be collected at the end of the school day.

Library Books

Your child should come home with a Banded reading book– this will be Reading Age appropriate.

They will also come home with a choice of two library books. These will be free choice and therefore not always age appropriate.

Homework

The Homework books are very much the same as last year.

- At the front is the choice sheet. Your child will need to chose one of these to complete once a week.
- Your child will have weekly spellings; please can you reinforce these at home.
- We would like your child to read to an adult three times a week.
- Our main focus for Maths homework is practising times-tables. Your child should know which table they are currently learning.
- Please get your child to try to do Sumdog as often as possible in a week. The activities on here will be times-table related.

Please record all the homework completed in the back of their Homework books on the recording sheet provided so we can reward your child's efforts accordingly.



Water bottles

Can I remind you that your child needs a water bottle at school.

This needs to have a **sports top, only be filled with water and should be named.**



PE - Thursday Games - Friday



Jewellery, apart from earrings, should not be worn to school. Earrings should be studs or hoops no bigger than a little finger in diameter. They will not be allowed to be worn for PE and Games. If your child is unable to take part in Games or PE, please could you send in a letter explaining the problem to the class teacher.
