Spring Term 1

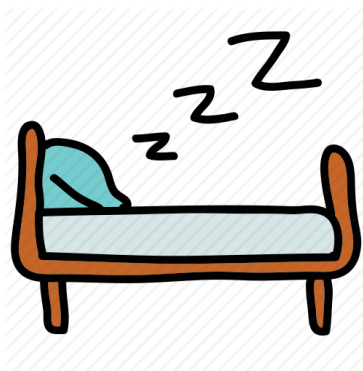
Welcome back. We hope you had a wonderful Christmas and New Year.
